Nominations shall only be presented for Primary Association members of Northwest Ohio REALTORS who are in good standing and have been a Primary member of Northwest Ohio REALTORS or 12 consecutive months prior to nomination. Application may be presented by the nominee, REALTOR members or Affiliate members of Northwest Ohio REALTORS. Applications presented by non-members of the Association will not be considered.

All submissions must be typed. Forms submitted with hand written information will not be considered.

REALTOR OF THE YEAR Selection – Each application that is received is assigned a number, and identification of the applicant is blacked out. The President will appoint a selection committee of 7 REALTOR members (and the Chief Executive Officer who serves as a non-voting member) who are given each application and a score card. Each area of the application has been assigned a maximum number of points. Committee members will score each application and submit them to the CEO who will tally the score for each application prior to the selection committee's meeting.
